

Info from the Deans Crew

- The staff at Bloom Trail receives a large number of emails daily from students and parents. In order for the staff to respond more efficiently, it would help if you follow the guidelines below: **1)** Please do NOT write the entire message in the subject line. **2)** Please include the **name of the student** and the **ID number** if you have it. **3)** If you are contacting a teacher, please include the **class period** your student has with that teacher. **4)** Please type a detailed message. **5)** Last but not least, please provide the phone number or the best way to contact you.
- Teachers are marking students tardy if they arrive late to their virtual classes. Students need to be on time for their virtual classes the same way they would need to be on time if they were in person. The Deans are tracking these tardies and will follow up with individual students. If the student is having technical difficulties that caused them to be late, it is the student's responsibility to contact the teacher and notify them so that an adjustment can be made.
- Another reminder that the district is STRICTLY monitoring activity on your Chromebooks no matter what day or time that you are using it.

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- **PE Department Message.** During the workout or active part of PE, it is the expectation that the video is displayed and that the PE teacher can see all of the students participating. If a student is not visible during the exercise portion of class, the student is given a redirect to turn their camera on or adjust their video. If the student does not follow the redirect, another redirect will be given. If the student still does not comply, they will be removed from the class. The PE teachers have incorporated this policy to protect ALL of the students that are actively participating in the virtual classes. During participation, students must be visible for safety reasons. If the student is removed from class or they are having technical difficulties, they have the opportunity to record themselves doing the lesson at a later time and submitting it directly to the PE teacher. If the student has been removed from class, the parent will be notified by the PE teacher. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact your student's PE teacher.
