All populations in Illinois can receive the vaccine regardless of insurance coverage, immigration status, including individuals who are undocumented.

This clinic is a *first dose* clinic only. Anyone who registers will be automatically registered for their *second dose* at Bloom Trail High School on *Friday, July 2nd*, *2021* at the same time as your first appointment.

A consent form will need to be signed by *parent* or *legal guardian* if the recipient is a minor. Forms will be available on site.
