

IMPORTANT STUDENT HOMECOMING Information:

Homecoming Tickets go on sale THIS Monday, Oct 4th. Students need to fill out and have signed by a parent or guardian a permission slip prior to purchasing a ticket. These can be found at the Bookstore.

NO Guests will be allowed this year. Based on capacity limits we want to first only open it to Juniors and Seniors. From there depending on availability we can open it up to underclassmen.

Juniors and Seniors will have the first opportunity to purchase tickets beginning October 4th-8th. At this time, underclassmen with a completed permission slip can go on the waitlist. Underclassmen can begin purchasing tickets along with the rest of the student body starting Monday, Oct. 11- Friday October 15th... **OR until tickets are sold out.**

******Students who have had severe behavioral referrals, chronic absences or chronic tardiness that have required them to see their Dean are not eligible to attend the dance. If a student has questions regarding their eligibility please see your dean.**

Tickets are \$25. Students can earn a discount by using their CREW CASH. For each 10 CREW dollars a student submits they can earn \$1off their ticket....not to exceed \$3off (for a maximum of 30 CREW dollars submitted.

- All Covid and CDC safety guidelines will be followed.
- Face Masks are required
- The dance begins at 4 pm. Doors will close at 6:00pm. The dance will end promptly at 8pm.
- The goodnight rule will be enforced. If you leave you cannot return.
- No refunds or ticket exchanges will be given for any reason.
- Dance will be held on the Bloom Trail Football field
- Students with outstanding balances must pay 10% of their balance with a cap of \$50.
- All school rules are in effect at all school functions.
- Students must present a valid ticket and school ID to enter. Tickets can NOT be resold or given to anyone and can only be used by the person who purchased the ticket.

Dress code is strictly enforced. (Please see handbook and online reminder)

Students who are in violation of the dress code will NOT be allowed to enter. There will be no refunds for students who are refused admittance into the dance based on dress code violations.

Please REMEMBER WE WILL BE OUTSIDE in October. Dress for the weather as it may be cold.

No frayed, ripped, or sagging pants/ jeans

No see-thru fabrics

No bare midriffs

No T-shirt

NO HEELS or cleats (gym shoes, sandals, flat shoes, etc are encouraged)

MASKS ARE REQUIRED

Modest, non-provocative, non-revealing semi-formal dresses are encouraged but not required

Dresses cannot have extreme slits or short hemlines (no more than fingertip length)

Dresses may not dip in the back below waistline.

Dresses must cover belly button. Belly Button MUST NOT be visible.

Dresses must not allow excessive cleavage to be shown.

Pants: dress pants/slacks, dress jeans

Button/collared Shirts..... Tie – optional

Sweaters and coats are encouraged.
